

2022 HERRESHOFF CLASSIC YACHT REGATTA

& NEWPORT-TO-BRISTOL FEEDER RACE August 26-28, 2022 Part of the CYOA Classic Yachts Challenge Series Hosted by the Herreshoff Marine Museum

NOTICE OF RACE

1. ORGANIZING AUTHORITY

1.1. The Organizing Authority (OA) for the Herreshoff Classic Yacht Regatta (HCYR) and the Newport-to-Bristol Feeder Race is the Herreshoff Marine Museum (HMM).

2. RULES

- 2.1. Both events will be governed by the following rules...
 - 2.1.1. The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS 2021-2024), US Sailing Prescriptions.
 - 2.1.2. The 2022 Classic Yachts Challenge Series (CYCS) Regulations
 - 2.1.3. The 2022 Classic Rating Formula (CRF 2022)
 - 2.1.4. Relevant One-Design and Formula class rules
- 2.2. For the purposes of rules 14 and 44.1, any contact between boats shall be considered serious damage. This changes rule 44.1.
- 2.3. In the event of a conflict between this Notice of Race (NOR) and the Sailing Instructions (SIs), the SIs shall prevail. This changes rule 63.7.

3. ADVERTISING

- 3.1. Advertising will be permitted in accordance with ISAF Regulation 20 and One-Design class rules as appropriate.
- 3.2. Participants may be required to fly sponsor flags as provided by the OA.

4. ELIGIBILITY

- 4.1. Both events are open to boats with a valid 2022 Classic Rating Formula (CRF 2022) rating certificate. Visit the CYOA site at <u>www.classicyachts.org/ratings</u> to get or renew a certificate.
- 4.2. Herreshoff S Class and H12 eligibility shall be in accordance with class rules.

5. DIVISION OF CLASSES

- 5.1. Boats racing under CRF 2022 will be divided into divisions based on their designation on their CRF Certificate or Day Racer, should they choose this option upon registering. In addition, within each CRF division there may be a Spinnaker and non-Spinnaker sub-divisions depending on the number of entries.
- 5.2. The OA reserves the right to consolidate divisions into classes for a mixed-fleet start to expedite racing.
- 5.3. The Herreshoff S Class and the H12 Class will race as one-design fleets.

6. ENTRY

- 6.1. Eligible boats must register online at herreshoff.org/regatta. Entries must be received on or before Friday, August 19th, 2022. Entries received after that date may be accepted at the discretion of the Organizing Authority and will be subject to a late entry fee of \$50.00.
- 6.2. The Entry Fees are as follows:

<30' LOA	\$300
30'-50' LOA	\$350
>50' LOA	\$450
Herreshoff S Class	\$275

- 6.3. The entry fee is refundable (minus a \$15 handling fee) if notice of cancellation is received by HMM on or before Friday, August 19th.
- 6.4. The entry fee includes the Newport-to-Bristol Feeder Race.
- 6.5. The entry fee for all boats includes one ticket to the Saturday night regatta dinner. Additional dinner tickets must be purchased in advance online at herreshoff.org/regatta.
- 6.6. An online liability waiver shall be submitted by each sailor prior to racing. Yachts without properly signed waivers may not be scored. In the event of a crew substitution, the new crew member shall complete an online waiver prior to racing. A link to the online waiver form can be found at herreshoff.org/regatta.
- 6.7. Yachts must have a valid CRF 2022 rating certificate on file with CYOA.
- 6.8. 12-Metres not racing in a CRF division must hold a valid class measurement certificate.
- 6.9. Certificates should be submitted via email at regatta@herreshoff.org.
- 6.10. Each boat must elect to use her spinnaker or non-spinnaker rating by 1200 EDT on Wednesday, August 24th. Any boat which does not notify the OA of her selection at <u>regatta@herreshoff.org</u> by the deadline will be scored using her spinnaker rating.

7. RACE HEADQUARTERS

The Race Headquarters will be in the waterfront tent at the Herreshoff Marine Museum at 7.1. 1 Burnside Street, Bristol RI.

- 8.1. Two races are scheduled for all yachts on Saturday.
- 8.2. One race may be run for all classes prior to the Bristol-to-Newport Race on Sunday.

9. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 9.1. SIs and class assignments for the Herreshoff Classic Yacht Regatta will be available at the Mandatory Skippers' Meeting held in under the tent at HMM at 1000 on Saturday, August 27th and at <u>herreshoff.org/regatta</u>.
- 9.2. SIs and class assignments for the Newport-to-Bristol Feeder Race will be available online at <u>herreshoff.org/regatta</u> and from the Race Committee prior to the start on Friday.

10. RACING AREA AND COURSES

- 10.1. The Herreshoff Classic Yacht Regatta will be sailed on Upper Narragansett Bay. The Race Committee will designate courses using government marks and inflatable marks as specified in the SIs.
- 10.2. The Newport-to-Bristol Feeder Race will start in the vicinity of Gould Island and will finish in the vicinity of the Herreshoff Marine Museum. The Race Committee will designate the course using government marks and inflatable marks as specified in the SIs.

11. PENALTY SYSTEM

- 11.1. The Scoring Penalty of rule 44.3 will apply. The penalty shall be 20% of the number of boats entered in the applicable class. The minimum penalty shall be 2 places.
- 11.2. The penalty, if any, for a violation of a rule other than a rule of Part 2, shall be at the sole discretion of the Protest Committee, and may be other than disqualification. This changes rule 64.1.

12. SCORING

- 12.1. One completed race constitutes a series.
- 12.2. A boat's score will be the total of all her race scores. This alters rule A2.
- 12.3. <u>Handicap classes will be scored using corrected speed</u> based on CRF 2021 ratings and course distances calculated using 81.0 as a scratch boat calculation for all CRF classes. Corrected speed scoring is preferable as it allows for normalization across different course lengths.
- 12.4. One-Design classes will be scored level.
- 12.5. Each day's racing will be scored separately, and only the Herreshoff Classic Yacht Regatta scores for CRF divisions on Saturday, August 27th will be part of the Classic Yachts Challenge Series (CYCS).
- 12.6. Boats eligible for the CYCS will be scored for the Series in accordance with the 2022 CYCS NOS.
- 12.7. CYCS scoring categories may or may not coincide with class splits utilized for starts or other regatta awards.
- 12.8. If ties continue to exist after the application of rule A8, they will be broken by determining the highest cumulative corrected speed.

13. **PRIZES**

13.1. Awards for all divisions/classes will be presented at the Saturday night regatta dinner at HMM.

14. SAIL AND EQUIPMENT LIMITATIONS

14.1. Per 2022 Classic Yachts Challenge Series Rules and One-Design class rules.

15. DOCKAGE AND MOORINGS

- 15.1. Dockage and moorings are available at HMM on a first come-first served basis. Boats are advised to bring sufficient dock lines and extra fenders. Reservation requests must be made online at via the <u>HMM Dockwa</u> online reservation form. HMM monitors VHF channel 72.
- 15.2. Participants may make arrangements for commercial dockage/moorings by contacting the following directly:

16. RADIO COMMUNICATION

- 16.1. All boats must carry a radio capable of making and receiving marine VHF transmissions.
- 16.2. Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make nor receive radio transmissions not available to all boats.

17. INSURANCE

17.1. Each boat shall hold adequate insurance including third-party liability insurance. It is the helmsman's sole and inescapable responsibility to ensure that the insurance is valid and adequate prior to participating in this event.

18. MEDIA RELEASE

18.1. Competitors and crew members on the competing yachts grant, at no cost, the Herreshoff Marine Museum, event sponsors, regatta photographers and affiliated companies the absolute right and permission to use their name, voice, image, likeness, biographical material and representations of the boats in any media worldwide (including but not limited to television, video, print and electronic media), for the sole purposes of advertising, promoting, reporting and disseminating information regarding the Herreshoff Classic Yacht Regatta and all participants therein.

19. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

19.1. Sailing is an activity that carries with it an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors participate in this regatta entirely at their own risk and are reminded to pay special attention to rule 4, Decision to Race. The race organizers including the OA, Race Committee, Protest Committee, the State of Rhode Island, sponsors, volunteers, or any other affiliated organization or official will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of practice or participation in this event in both shore-side and on-the-water activities. By participating in this event, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.
